

## **Equine Liability Waiver Form for Turkey Creek Ranch**

In consideration for receiving permission from Turkey Creek Ranch (TCR) to use their facilities and equipment and to participate in equine activities such as, but not limited to, horseback / pony riding, stagecoach rides, hayrides, express wagon rides, I agree that my use of those facilities and that equipment and my participation in those equine activities shall be undertaken at my own risk. I am aware that equine activities can be hazardous and involve inherent and other risks of personal injury, property damage, and death. I understand and agree that by signing this form I am expressly assuming those risks.

I also understand and agree that by signing this form, I am knowingly releasing, holding harmless, and agreeing to indemnify the TCR, Directorate of Family, Morale, Welfare, and Recreation, Fort Carson, the Department of the Army, and the United States, and their respective officers, agents, employees, contractors, and employees of those contractors, from any and all liability or costs, including attorney fees, for any claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions, or causes of action associated with or arising from my use of TCR facilities and equipment and my participation in equine activities.

My signature on this form is to bind not only me, but also my heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, personal representatives, and derivative claimants.
